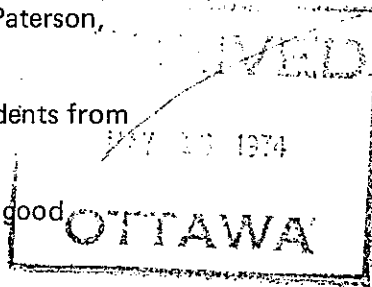
MAY MEETING
