Topic: Screw Liquid Chillers
Speaker: Mr. Ken Torrel, Dunham Bush
Canada Ltd.

Mr. Torrel will speak on the Development of the Helical Rotary Compressor and its application to Liquid Chillers. Although widely used in Europe for many years, its application in Canada has been limited until recently. Interest in energy conservation has encouraged engineers to re-examine the many advantages of the Screw Chiller, particularly in heat recovery applications. This has resulted in a greatly increased market, and Mr. Torrel will be discussing the ways in which engineers are using the chiller and the reasons behind their decisions.
