

# What You Missed

The first program meeting of the 2023/2024 OVC ASHRAE season was held on September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at The Westin Ottawa on Colonel By Drive. The meeting had 51 members, 7 quests, and 4 students in attendance.

The theme of the meeting was Membership Promotion. The program for the evening was Decarbonization and Whole Life Carbon: Accelerating Net Zero Building Scalability, presented by OVC chapter's own Ghina Annan. O'Dell and Associates, and Mitsubishi Electric provided a tabletop displays for the **E-mail**: matthew.moore@chorley.com evening. Dinner was a plated meal, with baked salmon, salad, rice, and a

custard pastry desert. President Adrianne Mitani called the meeting to order and acknowledged the Algonquin Nation and our industry's connection to the unceded land. President Adrianne Mitani introduced the Executive, Board of Governors. Secretary Matthew Moore introduced the guests. MP Chair and Region II Student Activities RVC Elizabeth Primeau welcomed the new members. YEA Chair Jayson Bursill presented the upcoming MP/YEA/SA event, a boat cruise, on September 26th, on the Ottawa River. Josh Bourbonniere presented the upcoming Stroke Play Golf Tournament, taking place September 29th, 2023, at the Metcalfe Gold Club. Mitsubishi Electric, and O'Dell and Associates reps briefly presented their respective tabletop displays.

Evans Mutua presented the night's raffle for Research Promotion. The prize for the night was a pair of tickets to an upcoming Sens vs Maple Leafs game. Tickets were donated by Total HVAC. Following this, President Adrianne Mitani announced the program topic for the evening, Decarbonization and Whole Life Carbon: Accelerating Net Zero Building Scalability presented by Ghina Annan.

Ghina began by summarizing a brief history of the decarbonization movement in the building environment and related industries. Key terms and definitions related to quantifying decarbonization were presented. One particular definition key to the decarbonization effort, and discussed in detail was "EPD", or environmental product declaration. The EPD is the international standard for measuring global warming potential, or carbon footprint, in building construction products. Discussion was had on the EPD rating for various common construction products used today. When tabulated accurately, EPD can be an extremely valuable tool for measuring and assessing the carbon impact a potential building may have. Ghina also noted in conjunction with this topic, the importance of accessible information and the ability for design teams to use software capable of tabulating quantities of construction materials, such as BIM, to be able to use EPD effectively. It was of particular note that some countries in the EU have very good data on building EPD, while others have effectively zero data.

Attendees were kept engaged throughout the presentation by a number of group surveys accessed via QR code. These surveys helped facilitate discussion and helped participants identify where they may have had misconceptions on decarbonization topics.

The presentation finished off with a discussion on how to reduce embodied carbon in MEP specific systems. HVAC systems account for 74% of the embodied carbon over the life of a building, and a large part of this is due to the presence of large amount of metal alloys, such as steel, in the HVAC system. Some of the methods to reduce embodied carbon in MEP systems were identified as:

- Reducing the amount of ducts and pipe within the building
- Pay close note to the types of insulation being specified
- Design thermal storage systems
- Minimize refrigerant impacts

To close, President Adrianne Mitani thanked Ghina Annan. Adrianne also reminded the audience about the postmeeting survey. The next meeting is scheduled for October 17th at the Centurion Conference and Event Center.

# **2023 ASHRAE Stroke Play Golf Tournament Recap**


Thank you to everyone who participated in the annual ASHRAE Stroke Play Golf Tournament on Friday, September 29th at Metcalfe Golf Club.


